America today is increasingly defined by a sense of disillusionment. The collapse of shared belief has produced a fractured cultural landscape in which truth itself feels unstable. Political extremism, algorithmic media, social isolation, and consumer culture have blurred the line between reality and performance, leaving many with a persistent feeling that something fundamental has broken. While the source of this dissatisfaction differs vastly from person to person, at its heart there lies a common condition: alienation from truth, from one another, and from any coherent sense of the future. From this condition emerges a central question.

What constitutes contemporary American insanity?

*Good Morning America* grapples with this question. The exhibition examines the psychic landscape of contemporary America, exploring the exhaustion of endless consumerism, the pervasion of digital mediation, the normalization of violent extremism, the seduction of capitalist power structures, and the personal instability produced by life under constant political and economic pressure. At the same time, the featured work resists simple cynicism. Embedded within the exhibition is a search for hope amid the chaos of collapse.

Rather than offering a concrete stance on our current cultural moment, this exhibition functions as a site of reflection. Each artist approaches “American insanity” from a different angle, revealing how it shapes everyday life. In this sense, *Good Morning America* is not only an exhibition about decay, but also about reckoning. Reckoning with the stories America tells itself, with the systems that structure our experiences, and with the emotional consequences of living through a moment that increasingly feels untethered from reality.
